

Helping Children Cope with Divorce Seminar

Helping Children Cope with Divorce is a national, award-winning seminar designed to help parents understand what a child is experiencing as a result of divorce and how to respond to the child's needs.

"Helping Children Cope with Divorce" is a court-mandated program for parents involved in any lawsuit regarding the custody, visitation or paternity of a minor child. This mandate applies to nine counties: Tulsa, Wagoner, Rogers, Mayes, Osage, Pawnee, Washington, Craig and Nowata. Judges in other counties may also require parents to attend.

Registration Information

- Arrive **30 minutes early** to check in with the registrar to receive credit for your attendance. Persons arriving after 9 a.m. are not admitted, and must reschedule.
- Seats for pre-registered participants will be held until 8:45 a.m. and then will be available to walk-ins.
- Pre-registration is recommended. Classes fill up quickly.
- Pre-registration is accepted until three (3) business days before a seminar. Registration may close earlier if a seminar is full. Parties who wish to attend a seminar after the registration deadline may register at the door, space permitting.
- Pre-register online, in person (F&CS Central Office or Tulsa County Courthouse; info below) or by mail.
- Same day registration is available on a space available basis at the door of any seminar.
- Same day registration is \$55.

- Tulsa and Broken Arrow Seminars: \$45 with pre-registration, \$55 at the door

What Else Do You Need To Know?

- If you fail to attend your scheduled seminar date, a \$20 rescheduling fee will be charged.
- Do not bring children to the program.
- The court requires that parties attend the entire four-hour seminar. Late arrivals will be asked to reschedule. No exceptions.

- Participants receive a Certificate of Completion at the end of the seminar.
- The court is notified of your attendance only if you have included your court case number and the name of the county in which your motion is filed.
- Interpreter services for hearing-impaired participants are available by prior request.
- Cancellation/refund requests must be made in writing prior to the scheduled seminar date.
- Fees may be reduced with pre-registration for persons qualifying under the guidelines of F&CS.
